NYC Parks is the steward of over 30,000 acres of land — 14 percent of New York City — including more than 5,000 individual properties ranging from Coney Island Beach and Central Park to community gardens and Greenstreets. We operate more than 800 athletic fields and nearly 1,000 playgrounds, 1,800 basketball courts, 550 tennis courts, 67 public pools, 51 recreational facilities, 15 nature centers, 14 golf courses, and 14 miles of beaches. We care for 1,200 monuments and 23 historic house museums. We look after 600,000 street trees, and two million more in parks. We are New York City's principal providers of recreational and athletic facilities and programs. We are home to free concerts, world-class sports events, and cultural festivals.

Since 2009, the mobile movie van has provided free outdoor movies in underserved neighborhoods in all five Boroughs. The van is equipped with a state-of-the-art \$40K audio / video system, a 14'X8' small screen and a 20'x11' inflatable screen.

Perks -All seasonal employees earn sick and annual leave. All employees receive free membership to our recreation centers.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Drive to and from garage to various Parks around the five boroughs.
- Set up and breakdown movie screen and audio equipment. May need to lift heavy objects up to 50 pounds.
- Work closely with Parks Managers and borough coordinators to ensure that movie shows are professionally implemented.
- Evaluate movie sites and ensure that locations are safe and feasible.
- Maintain accurate records such as daily vehicle trip ticket, van inventory and program sign-in sheets.
- Maintain mobile unit vehicle; keep van neat and organized. Keep inventory of equipment and update citywide and borough coordinator on repairs needed of vehicle and replacement of supplies.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Three years of participation in an art, craft or other recreational pursuit as a teacher, performer, coach, official, contestant or demonstrator, including at least one year of experience in that art, craft or other recreational pursuit to be performed on the job; or
- 2. Major study in that art, craft or other recreational pursuit to be performed on the job, acquired in a high school, college or other appropriate institution over at least a three year period; or
- 3. A satisfactory equivalent combination of education and experience as described above.

PREFERRED SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS

- At least two years' experience working with a variety of audio/visual equipment including video conferencing units, LCDs, laptop 1. computers and amplification systems.
- Experience with live event production and audio-visual technical experience, including some previous supervisory experience. 2.
- College credits or certification from a technical training school specializing in audio video, multi-media productions or a related subject. 3.
- Extensive knowledge of audiovisual equipment and computer software systems. 4.
- 5. Experience working with the public in a community setting.
- Valid New York State driver's license and driving knowledge of New York City. 6.
- 7. Ability to lift heavy objects.

Residency in New York City, Nassau, Orange, Rockland, Suffolk, Putnam, or Westchester counties required for employees with over two years of city service. New York City residency required for all other candidates within 90 days of hire.

Fees: Hired candidates will be subject to a processing fee of \$40.00. Hired candidates who are not currently employed by the City will be subject to a \$101.25 background check fee.
