We are New York City's principal providers of recreational and athletic facilities and programs. We are home to free concerts, world-class sports events, and cultural festivals.

We seek candidates to provide administrative support to our Aquatics program.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Organize, distribute and collect aquatic related program materials and equipment.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent, and either
 - a) Two summer seasons, or six months, of experience as an instructor, counselor, or coach in an organized recreational program; or
 - b) Completion of sixty credits toward a baccalaureate degree in an accredited college; or
- 2. Education and/or experience equivalent to "1" above.

PREFERRED SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Excellent communication and organizational skills.
- 2. Strong customer service skills.

Residency in New York City, Nassau, Orange, Rockland, Suffolk, Putnam or Westchester counties required for employees with over two years of city service. New York City residency required for all other candidates within 90 days of hire.
