Open short range view:
 Remove all scrub growth below canopy, raise canopy to 20', plant low growing flowering shrubs.

Improve appearance of area:
 Including planting, removal of storage containers, and removal of parking.

Open long range views:
 Remove volunteer trees, thin & prune existing trees, do not plant new trees.
